Oversight and management of the program is the responsibility of the DNR Division of Enforcement, Safety/Education section.

If any members have children or grandchildren ages 10 – 15 encourage them to enroll in the ATV online safety training class, visit www.dnr.state.mn.us/safety/vehicle/atv/index.html#calendar, The online class is a prerequisite to the hands-on safety class. Our club will be holding this class later this year. Once scheduled this class or classes will be posted and promoted.

Also anyone born after July 1, 1987, or who is 16 years or older must complete the ATV safety online course to be able to utilize MN DNR GIA Trails.
