# **ATV Ordinance**

On Tuesday April 16<sup>th</sup> 2024 The Cass County Board of Commissioners held their board meeting. On the agenda was public hearing 4<sup>th</sup> reading of Ordinance 2024-01, regulating the use of All Terrain Vehicles on county highways and public right of ways. Allowing class I ATV's to operate on county roads. There was a very short comment period (2 minutes) where there was no additional comments or changes suggested. There was a motion made to approve the 4<sup>th</sup> reading and adopt Cass County Ordinance 2024-01 as written. The motion was seconded and a vote to enact the ordinance was taken. All board members voted in favor. The ordinance was adopted and will become effective after 30 days, May 16<sup>th</sup>. The Cass County ATV Ordinance can be found on the county web site. - Classes open to ALL individuals who want to learn how to better operate an ATV
- Arrive 30 min. early for unloading ATV and Sign-in/Registration paperwork

#### Pre-Requisites for achieving ATV Safety Certificate:

- ✓ Must be a minimum of 12 years of age to apply for ATV Safety Certificate
- Students age 16 and older, or born after July 1, 1987, must complete the ATV Safety online course to apply for MN DNR ATV Safety Certificate (Not required to attend ATV safety Hands-On class)



## **Obstacle Course Rebuild**

In preparation of the upcoming ATV Safety Classes, members of the Woodtick Wheelers ATV Club along with the Cass County Sheriff's Office took time to evaluate the condition of the obstacle course and rebuild or replace what is needed. The Woodtick Wheelers elected to use funds that were earned thru the Minnesota DNR Trail Ambassador program, These funds are required to be used on education and safety expenses. The safety course rebuild is an appropriate expense.

Thank you so much for this. We spent approximately 4.5 hours dismantling the ramps and obstacles, then proceeded with replacing and re-assembling with new materials.
