“Fall Color Ride”

Saturday October 5th, 2024

Wilderness Wheelers ATV Club President Rick Schultz has agreed to lead the Woodtick Wheelers on this trail system. The plan is to be in Bigfork, at the trail head parking area, Rajala Mill Road just west of Hwy 38 (Main Ave) for a 9:00am start time. The plan is to ride for approximately 2 ½ to 3 hours, stopping every hour for breaks, stop for lunch 1 hour, then a 2-hour ride back to the trailhead in Bigfork.

This is the route Rick is suggesting for our ride.

Bigfork - take B&B trail to Wilderness Trail, take Wilderness trail through Marcell over to Riley’s have lunch. Leave there, go to Hayslip in Talmoon, leave there go up the Spur Lake Road to the Arrowhead, cross Hwy 6 to the Jungle Lake Road to Hwy 38 down to the Farm Camp Road to County Road 7 back to Bigfork.
